- VENUE:** Moneystown, Ashford Co. Wicklow, by kind permission of the owner.
NO DOGS ALLOWED
- START TIME:** **11.30 a.m.** Competitors to check in at **11.00 a.m.** Drivers & Observers briefing will be held at **11.15 a.m.**
- COURSE:** The course will be of a sporting nature and will consist of observed sections only. Competitors must follow the intended line of each section. Competitors are requested not to damage private property and to bring home any litter. No crossing of tracks is permitted. Competitors are not permitted to alter the Course under any circumstances. Doing so may result in exclusion from the event as per GCR 142.
- CARS/TYRES** Per current Motorsport Ireland Yearbook and Sept. 2011 Bulletin. The Club reserves the right to scrutinise cars at any time.
- CREW:** Two entries will be accepted in respect of each car. Drivers, Passenger and Bouncers must keep their feet on the cockpit floor within the confines of the car. Standing is not allowed. No competition car may be driven on any part of the course or adjoining lands by any person other than a person who has entered the event and signed the official entry form. Breach of this regulation may merit exclusion. Drivers must advise the check-in official if they retire. Unsporting behaviour may merit exclusion from the results. All competitors must possess a current Motorsport Ireland licence to be produced on demand. No competitor may receive assistance, advice or direction whilst traversing a section, except Juniors in their first season.
- JUNIORS** Junior competitors aged between 14 & 16 yrs may enter for the event. Such competitors must be in possession of a Junior licence and must be accompanied in the car by a holder of a full competition licence at all times except when competing in a section.
- START ORDER** A draw to determine the starting order will be held and will be displayed at the check-in point. Each driver must complete his first lap in the draw sequence and in turn. Where a driver on his first lap arrives at a section and the previous section has not yet been punched, he will be penalised 10 marks. Doubling up is permitted on the second lap.
- MARKS/TIES** As published in the Motorsport Ireland Yearbook. A **10 mark "Roll" penalty** for each roll by a driver will be added to their final score.
- AWARDS** Lincoln & Nolan Cup and Replica. 1st. – 5th. Grades A,B,C,D 1st Junior.
- RESULTS** Bel Air Hotel, Ashford.
- ONE DAY** One Day licences are available on the day for competitors 14 yrs and over.
- ENTRIES** On the enclosed form. The club reserves the right to refuse entries without assigning a reason.
- ENTRIES TO** Dave Smyth, Homeleigh, Blackhorse Avenue, Dublin 7. Closing date for entries is 13th February, 2012. Incomplete, late or unpaid entries will be ignored.
